RIGHTS OF APPEAL

Section 43(1) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 provides that:

Where, except in pursuance of a direction given by the National Assembly for Wales, a licence is granted subject to conditions, the applicant may appeal from the decision to the National Assembly for Wales.

- a statement indicating whether you wish the appeal to be in the form of a hearing or on the basis of written representations.

You are also required to serve a copy of your notice of appeal, together with copies of any the above documents that have accompanied your notice of appeal, on the Environment Agency (at the address below). You should appeal within 6 months of the date that this notice takes effect but the National Assembly for Wales may allow notice of appeal to be given after the expiry of this time period.

Conditions 1.1.1, 1.2.1, 1.2.2, 1.2.3, Annex 1 are deleted and replaced as follows:

1.1 Specified waste management operations

1.1.1 No waste management operations shall be authorised by this licence unless:

- a specified in and undertaken in accordance with the limitations in the following table; or
- b otherwise required by the conditions of this licence as being an integral part of those operations;

1.2 Permitted wastes

Permitted categories and types of waste

- 1.2.1 No waste other than those categorised below in Table 1.2A, specified in detail in section 1.2 of the working plan and Annex 1 to these of the shall be accepted at the site.

Permitted quantities of waste

- 1.2.2 The quantities of wastes accepted shall not exceed those listed in Table 1.2A and specified in detail in section 1.2 of the working plan. Whilst complying with the maximum quantities specified for each type of waste, the total quantity of waste accepted at the site per year shall not exceed 1950 tonnes.

Permitted waste categories are indicated using the European Waste Catalogue (EWC), these are subject to maximum total quantity stipulated in conditions 1.1 and 1.2 of this licence.
