Introductory note

This introductory note does not form a part of the notice

The following notice gives notice of the variation of an environmental permit.

Schedule 1 of the Environmental Permitting Regulations was updated by the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2013 to reflect the implementation of the Industrial Emissions Directive (IED) into England and Wales. Following this, Natural Resources Wales has varied Schedule C: Operational Conditions - Operation section of the permit to include limits which the operator must operate below to remain a waste facility, resulting from the introduction of the Industrial Emissions Directive.

The site technically has the capacity to operate above the threshold limits detailed within the IED, specifically S5.6A(1)(a), temporary storage of hazardous waste with a total capacity exceeding 50 tonnes, however, they have chosen to put physical measures in place to operate below the threshold to remain permitted as a waste facility. Therefore, Natural Resources Wales has included these physical limits within the permit to incorporate them as an enforceable permit condition.

The schedules specify the changes made to the original permit.

The status log of a permit sets out the permitting history, including any changes to the permit reference number.

The following conditions are amended as detailed, following an NRW initiated variation

Schedule C: Operational Conditions: Operation section is amended to include the following:

40. Temporary storage of hazardous waste, pending any of the activities listed in Sections 5.1, 5.2 and 5.3 of the environmental permitting regulations shall not exceed a total capacity of 50 tonnes. This includes any underground storage of hazardous waste but does not include temporary storage pending collection of waste generated on site.
