Natural Resources Wales considers that the following conditions of the environmental permit are being contravened:

Condition 1.1.1 The operator shall manage and operate the activities:

- (a) In accordance with a written management system that identifies and minimises risks of pollution, including those arising from operations, maintenance, accidents, incidents, non-conformances, closure and those drawn to the attention of the operator as a result of complaints; and

Condition 2.2 .1 Waste shall only be accepted if:

- (b) It is of a type and quantity listed in table 2.2 below

Condition 3.1.1 Emission of substances not controlled by emission limits (excluding odour) shall not cause pollution. The operator shall not be taken to have breached this rule if appropriate measures, including, but not limited to, those specified in Table 3.1 below and not in any approved emissions management plan

Table 3.1 Appropriate measures for emissions not controlled by emission limits

1. Uncontaminated plastic, glass and ferrous and non-ferrous metal wastes arising from the treatment of end-of-life vehicles shall be stored on hard standing or an impermeable surface with sealed drainage system. All other wastes shall be stored on an impermeable surface with a sealed drainage system

Condition 3.1,1 Emission of substances not controlled by emission limits (excluding odour) shall not cause pollution

Condition 1.1.1 – There is no environmental management system in place

Condition 2.2.1 - The site are accepting, treating and storing scrap metal which is not permitted. There are waste motor vehicle engines that have not been fully de-polluted stored on unmade ground

Condition 3.1.1 The drainage on site is not a sealed drainage system.

Condition 3.1.1 Waste oil can be seen discharging via the interceptor to surface water.

You are required to take the steps set out in Schedule 1 by the dates specified in order to remedy the contravention.

#### **General**

1. Failure to comply with this notice is an offence under Regulation 38(3) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010 and may result in legal action being taken against you.
2. Without prejudice to the requirements of this notice, failure to comply with a condition of an environmental permit is an offence and may result in legal action being taken against you.
3. You may wish to seek independent legal advice.

#### **Appeal provisions**

You are entitled to appeal against this notice under Regulation 31(2)(f) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010. Notice of appeal must be made within two months of the date of this notice. An appeal does not affect the requirements of this notice.

The required documents are:

a statement of the grounds of appeal;  
a copy of any relevant application;  
a copy of any relevant environmental permit;  
a copy of any relevant correspondence between the appellant and the regulator;  
a copy of any decision or notice which is the subject matter of the appeal; and  
a statement indicating whether you wish the appeal to be in the form of a hearing or dealt with by way of written representations.

You may withdraw an appeal by notifying Welsh Ministers in writing and sending a copy of that notification to us.

Further information about making an appeal and the forms that you will need are available from the Environmental Protection Division.
