

Non-Technical Summary

Install Waste Management Ltd. has developed plans for the application of an environmental permit to allow the importation of mixed waste materials to be processed on site. The business will benefit from the reduction in distances travelled by its vehicles and the financial savings of segregating and sorting like materials.

This application seeks a new Environmental Permit to allow the physical treatment, transfer and storage of waste within a building on a concrete floor (impermeable pavement); therefore, there will be no emissions to air, land or water. The treatment at the facility will primarily include mechanical separation; the storage of segregated materials will only be pending removal from site. The waste materials included in this application are as per the standard rules permit SR2008 No3.

Other than the issue of SSSI proximity this permit application meets all the conditions set out in the standard rules permit, *SR2008 No3 50kte household, commercial and industrial waste transfer station and treatment*. The SSSI is closest at approximately 200m south of the site.

The current activities (under exemption) have had no impact on the SSSI to date and it is not foreseen that a continuation of this and similar activities, undertaken under similar levels of control, will alter the situation.
