STATEMENT OF SPECIFIED CONDITIONS
(SECTION 11 CONTROL OF POLLUTION ACT 1974)

1. Waste deposited at the site shall be limited to material from within the Borough of Newport other than special waste as defined by the Control of Pollution (Special Wastes) Regulations 1980. All waste shall be inspected and suspect materials reported forthwith to the disposal authority.
2. Separate records shall be kept of the quantities of domestic, commercial and industrial waste deposited on the site.
3. An approved notice board showing the name of the site, hours when the site is open, types of waste accepted, scale of charges, name and telephone number of the responsible officer, shall be displayed at the site entrance.
4. Suitable site control office and facilities for the storage and servicing of plant shall be provided and maintained in good order.
5. Gates and boundary fences shall be maintained in good order.
6. Suitable lighting shall be provided as necessary to facilitate operations after dark.
7. Water courses on and adjacent to the site shall be diverted, culverted, or otherwise protected from obstruction or pollution.
8. Suitable arrangements shall be made for the drainage of surface water from the site.
9. The site shall be adequately manned and supervised whenever open to the public.
10. No traffic shall be admitted to any unmanned area of the site.
11. All reasonable efforts shall be made to discourage persons without business on the site.
12. The approach road from Docks Way, entrance and amenity area shall be kept clean, litter free and in good order.
13. Site roads shall be maintained in reasonable condition, free of damaging protrusions.
14. In dry weather all roads shall be sprayed with water as necessary to suppress dust.
15. All reasonable efforts shall be made to drain any large body of water before depositing waste, other than inert material, into it.
16. Filling shall be contained within compact cells, so far as reasonably practicable.

17. Moveable screens or other barriers shall be provided as necessary to contain litter within working areas. Litter arrested by such screens shall be removed and disposed of daily. Litter escaping shall be collected promptly.
18. Animal carcasses, other animal or fish waste, or obnoxious materials shall be deposited in front of the working face and immediately covered with other waste, so that the obnoxious material is not within 1 metre of the surface or 2 metres of the flank or face.
19. Except as above solid waste shall be spread in layers of about 200 mm on a sloping face not steeper than 1 in 3, and thoroughly compacted as soon as possible after deposit.
20. The total depth of material placed in one day shall not exceed 2.5 metres.
21. At the end of each day, suitable non-putrescible cover material shall be spread as necessary to minimise wind-blown litter or other nuisance.
22. Completed areas shall be graded, and a final capping of suitable non-putrescible material not less than 300mm thick placed as soon as possible.
23. Finished slopes shall not be steeper than 1 in 10.
24. Completed areas shall be maintained in good order, and action shall be taken to control or destroy weeds where necessary.
25. No waste material shall be burnt within the boundaries of the site. A fire at the site shall be regarded as an emergency and immediate action taken to extinguish it. All outbreaks of fire shall be reported forthwith to the disposal authority.
26. Effective precautions shall be taken to deal with any vermin or insects on the site.
27. These Specified Conditions shall be made known to any person given responsibility for the management or control of the site, and a copy shall be displayed at the site control office.

APPENDIX

The following requirements do not form part of the Specified Conditions, and are subject to amendment after consultation between the Director of Environmental Services, the Director of Works and the Chairman of Public Works Committee as appropriate.

28. Waste is to be accepted every day except Bank Holidays during the following hours:

Main Site	7.30 to 16.00 Monday to Friday
	7.30 to 11.00 Saturday
Amenity Area	7.30 to 22.00 daily

29. Men and machines are to be available for 1 hour after times of closing the main site.
30. Whenever open to the public there should never be less than 2 men on site.
31. Amenity area and night skips are for domestic waste only.
32. No commercial or industrial waste is to be accepted after the advertised hours, except by the contract watchman, or under exceptional circumstances at the discretion of the site supervisor.
33. All waste is to be charged for except:
- Council refuse collections and civic amenity waste;
 - Other domestic waste;
 - Occasional loads of commercial and industrial waste under 1 tonne at the discretion of the site supervisor;
 - Cover material as required for daily use (This material may be accepted free of charge or at a rate agreed in consultation with the Borough Treasurer and the Chairman);
 - Capping material delivered by prior arrangement, and controlled, levelled and graded at the site by the haulier.
34. Staff and contractor's men about the entrance and amenity area should wear some recognisable "uniform" at all times.
35. The approach to members of the public must always be courteous and helpful.
36. The privacy of individuals and confidentiality of any documents must be respected.
37. No totting is to be permitted in any area where plant is operating.
38. Tracked machines must not travel on paved roads.
39. The steel wheel compactor must be kept off all surfaces used by road vehicles.
