PERMIT

Whereas on 31st day of July 1995



the Vale of Glamorgan Borough Council (hereinafter called the Waste Regulation Authority)

transferred to you Waste Management Licence No. 48 relating to the Facility for the Purpose of Keeping and Recycling Waste at your site at Unit 55, Gluepot Road, Llandow Trading Estate, Nr. Cowbridge, South Glamorgan subject to the Conditions set out therein.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Waste Regulation Authority modifies the said conditions as follows:

Section 2

Schedule 1: Types of Waste

Asbestos Waste	(1 No. 12 C/yd lockable skip)
LPG Containers	(Lockable open air compound)
Car Batteries	(1 No. lockable leakproof container)
Refrigerators	(50 No. per week)

Provide lockable storage facility for small amounts of other items of controlled waste which may be collected by the Authority under its duties imposed by Waste Management and Disposal legislation.

*[The Waste Regulation Authority hereby give notice that Section 43 (4) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 shall not apply for the reasons given in the attached statement.]

Section 6. OPERATIONS

6.5 The facility shall only be operated during the following hours:

Monday to Friday	08.00 - 17.00 hours
Saturday and Sunday	08.00 - 16.00 hours

Except in cases of emergency, no delivery or removal of waste shall take place outside these hours without prior approval of the Waste Regulation Authority. All circumstances of emergency shall be reported forthwith to the Waste Regulation Authority.

Such modifications shall take effect on 28th February, 1996.
