NOTICE OF MODIFICATION OF WASTE MANAGEMENT LICENCE

To: Cross Keys Motors Ltd,

WHEREAS on 25 February 1992 the Islwyn Borough Council granted to you a Waste Disposal Licence, now to be treated as a Waste Management Licence, Reference Number 1993/17 relating to a transfer station on land at Riverside Garage, Newtown Industrial Estate, Cross Keys subject to the conditions set out therein and in any subsequent Modifications.

NOTICE is HEREBY GIVEN that the Environment Agency ("the Agency") modifies the said conditions as follows:-

The following Conditions attached to Waste Management Licence Reference Number 1993/17 shall be deleted,

Condition Number(s): 18, Schedule C

and the attached Conditions, Waste Management Licence Reference Number 1993/17 shall be substituted.

New Condition No: 18; Schedule C

- 18.1 A record shall be kept of all wastes received and of all materials (wastes and recovered materials) removed from the site. The records shall include the following for each vehicle load of waste/material.
- for waste received*
 - (a) origin of waste
 - (b) date received
 - (c) quantities in tonnes received and waste type as specified in Condition No: 13, Schedule C
 - (d) nature of the waste (solid, liquid or sludge)
 - for waste/material removed*
 - (e) date removed
 - (f) quantities in tonnes removed and waste and/or material type
 - (g) destination of waste and/or materials removed
 - (h) nature of the waste and/or materials (solid, liquid or sludge)
- 18.2 A summary of the information, including nil returns shall be submitted to the Agency, in a format required by the Agency. Summaries shall be for each quarter of the financial year and shall be submitted to the Agency within one month of the end of each quarter.





New Condition No: 18.3, Schedule C

- 18.3 All records required to be kept under Condition 18.1, Schedule C of this licence shall be made available to any authorised representative of the Agency for inspection at any reasonable time.

New Condition No: 18.4, Schedule C

- 18.4 A record shall be kept of the types and quantities of waste inadvertently delivered to the facility, giving details of the final destination. The record shall comprise full details, as required, in a form agreed with the Agency and copies shall be sent to the Agency at a frequency as may be requested by the Agency. These records shall be made available for inspection by an authorised officer of the Agency at the facility at any reasonable time.

Such modification shall take effect on 31 March 1999 at 24.00 hours.
