NOTICE OF MODIFICATION TO WASTE MANAGEMENT LICENCE

To: Eco – Oil Limited,

WHEREAS on 3 December 1985, Newport Borough Council granted to Amatoil Limited a Waste Disposal Licence, Reference Number 037/85 relating to an oil treatment plant on land at Newquay Road, Newport subject to the conditions set out therein,

And WHEREAS on 3 April 1992, Newport Borough Council modified and renumbered the Waste Disposal Licence subject to conditions set out therein, Reference Number 037/92,

And WHEREAS on 1 May 1994 the said Waste Disposal Licence converted to a Waste Management Licence pursuant to section 77(2) of the Environment Protection Act 1990,

And WHEREAS on 20 March 1995, Newport Borough Council modified the Waste Management Licence subject to conditions therein,

And WHEREAS on 25 May 1995, Newport Borough Council transferred to Trinco Limited the above mentioned Waste Management Licence,

And WHEREAS on 25 May 1995, 17 January 1997, 20 June 1997 and 29 March 1999, the conditions of that licence were modified,

And WHEREAS on 19 November 2001, the Environment Agency ("the Agency") transferred to Eco-Oil Limited the above mentioned Waste Management Licence,

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Agency modifies the said conditions as follows:-

The following Condition shall be added into Waste Management Licence reference 037/92

Schedule C New Condition

56. The financial provision for meeting the obligations under this licence set out in the Agreement made between the Licence Holder and the Agency, dated 19 November 2001 shall be maintained by the Licence Holder throughout the subsistence of this licence and the Licence Holder shall produce evidence of such provision whenever required by the Agency.

This modification (Number 07) shall take effect on 19 November 2001 at 00.01 hours.

RIGHTS OF APPEAL

Section 43(1) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 provides that:

Where, except in pursuance of a direction given by the National Assembly for Wales

- (a) an application for a licence or a modification of the conditions to the licence is rejected;
- (b) a licence is granted subject to conditions;
- (c) the conditions of a licence are modified;

the applicant may appeal about the decision to the National Assembly for Wales

Therefore if you feel aggrieved by the decision or any of the conditions to the licence as granted you may obtain the appropriate form on which to give written notice of an appeal from:-

This notice of appeal should be accompanied by the following information: A copy of the licence; a copy of any correspondence relevant to the appeal; a copy of any other document relevant to the appeal including, in particular, any relevant consent, determination, notice, planning permission, established use certificate or certificate of lawful use or development; and a statement indicating whether you wish the appeal to be in the form of a hearing or on the basis of written representations. You are also required to serve a copy of your notice of appeal, together with copies of any of the above documents that have accompanied your notice of appeal, on the Environment Agency (at the address below.) You should appeal within 6 months of the date that this notice takes effect but the National Assembly for Wales may allow notice of appeal to be given after the expiry of this time period.
