Schedule

Emissions to Air

The H1 assessment provided on 04 May 2018 has been reviewed. The short term Process Contribution (PC) for PM₁₀ emissions in relation to the background concentration is significantly higher than the screening threshold of 20%, at 210%. Short term emissions of PM₁₀ do not screen out and as directed by the H1 assessment further modelling is therefore required. Detailed modelling must be carried out of the potential impact of short term emissions of PM₁₀ on human health and on conservation sites.

The list of potential receptors included in the Environmental Risk Assessment does not include all of the protected sites within the relevant screening distance, i.e. 10km for SACs, SPAs and RAMSARS, 2km for SSSIs and 2km for National Nature Reserves, Local Nature Reserves, Local Wildlife Sites and Ancient Woodland. Our screening picks up sites not already identified. Please ensure that the potential impacts of emissions from the facility are considered for all relevant sites.

Drainage

Site plan A103882-DP-01 provided on 04 May 2018 shows surface water drainage to the south of the main building described as draining to ground. Your permit does not currently allow emissions to ground. Is this a new emission or an existing one, and where is it coming from?

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
