We need more information about your application

Thank you for your application received on 28/02/2019.

We need to ask you for some more information before we can do any more work on it.
Please would you:

- Confirm you will have a management system in place which will meet our requirements (as per Question 3 on our B6.5 Application Form).
- From checking our systems it doesn't appear the payment of £125 has been paid (checked between 15/02/2019-18/03/2019). The payment must be made before we can determine the application.
- You have stated the volume originating from the Tea Room will be 3m³/day although you have not provided evidence for how this value was calculated. You must use the British Water – Flows and Loads 4 guidance to calculate the **Maximum** daily volume originating from the Tea Room. Please can you calculate the volume from the maximum number of staff and visitors per day.
