Application to Vary Environmental Permit AP3136AU

Please find enclosed Application Forms A, C2 and C3 and the requisite fee for an application by Dragon LNG Limited ("**Dragon**") to vary its existing Environmental Permit reference AP3136AU.

The application follows several pre-application consultation meetings with local inspector Mr. Gary Evans, Technical Specialist Pollution Prevention & Control (PPC), who is based at the NRW Llandarcy offices. It relates primarily to the installation of a new LNG reliquefaction plant to reliquefy boil-off gas, which following a period of testing commissioning, will lead to the decommissioning of the existing cogeneration plant. As discussed with Mr Evans, the application also seeks to address other minor matters relating to water releases and monitoring, to clarify and consolidate certain Conditions.

The proposed Reliquefaction Plant is a critical project for Dragon and one that it is relying upon to demonstrate compliance with IED. This has also been the subject of on-going discussions with NRW. It is also a critical project in that it will provide Dragon with operational flexibility which is essential in today's global LNG market.

Whilst the Reliquefaction Plant has received planning permission, some financial decisions are at a critical stage and to remove any uncertainty about the feasibility of the project, an early determination of the application would be appreciated. We would therefore request a prioritisation of the determination of the application. Dragon in turn will commit to prompt responses to any requests for clarification or further information during the determination period.
