In reply to CAR5640 and the eleven actions the actions taken are as follow:

Action 1: If there are any proposals to restart the waste to energy section of the site the operator will need to notify NRW immediately, prior to any work taking place and an agreed action plan discussed with the regulator.

As agreed, before the WTE section is considered to be restarted a meeting will be held with the NRW to see what conditions need to be met.

Action 2: Operator needs to vary the permit in respect of change that has taken place on the site e.g. the additional emission point from the de-duster at the rear of the process hall and increase in recovered recyclables and their storage and location.

The permit revision will be completed by the end of October 2014 and a meeting held with the NRW prior to this to discuss the changes required.

Action 3: Operator to provide a copy of the follow up Odournet report to NRW on completion.

Once the Odournet report has been completed, a copy of the said report will be provided to the NRW.

Action 4: Operator to provide an update to NRW on receipt of the further advice sought from OSIL and review of the follow up Odournet report regarding next steps to address the odour issue.

Once the Odournet report has been completed and the review undertaken a meeting will be held with the NRW to inform them of what the next steps are in regards to odour abatement on site.

Action 5: Operator to ensure that all bio-filter checks are being undertaken in accordance with protocols there should be no gaps in the data for when staff are off in order to fulfil the operating technique requirements.

From 22nd September 2014 all bio-filter checks will be completed with no gaps in the data.


Action 6: Operator to provide a non-draft copy of the most up to date Odour Management Plan for NRW records.

The Odour Management Plan is enclosed with this letter and an adobe copy sent to the Swansea offices, once the Odournet report has been completed, the Odour Management Plan will be updated.

Action 7: Operator to inform NRW of the proposed frequency of the MREC Liaison committee meetings following the 'mothballing' of the incinerator section of the plant.

The MREC Liaison committee meetings are to be held on a "Bi-annual" bases with the next meeting being held on the 19th November 2014 at 16:00hrs.
