Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010

I refer to your recent enquiry about the need for a permit or exemption for a waste treatment activity in Flint Mill. The burn out oven used to clean polypropylene from the application nozzles every few weeks was registered as a Paragraph 29 exemption under the previous permitting regime. This activity has been removed from the current regulations as the equivalent exemption does not refer to waste disposal by burning.

The activity does not fall into the lists of regulated activities under the recently amended Environmental Permitting Regulations and such activities are considered to be low risk and not requiring regulation. We would expect the activity to be managed within the site's Environmental Management System and good practice followed to minimise possible impact.
