Part surrender

We have decided to accept the surrender of part of the permit for Flint Paper Mill operated by Kimberly-Clark Limited.

The permit number is EPR/BJ9703IM.

We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to avoid any pollution risk and to return the site to a satisfactory state.

We consider in reaching that decision we have taken into account all relevant considerations and legal requirements.

Key issues of the decision

We are satisfied that this can be considered a low risk partial surrender as although during the life of this particular section of the site, there have been a number potentially polluting substances used, these have always been kept within containers surrounded by a bund and taken off site with no pollution incidents during phase 1 of the demolition of Delyn Mill.
