If You Discover a Fire

- Shut any doors and raise the alarm by shouting "FIRE FIRE FIRE"
- Leave buildings by the nearest available Fire Exit
- Telephone 999 and request the attendance of the Fire Service, provide the site details as above and any other mobile telephone number you may be ringing from
- Vacate the site and report to the designated Assembly Point which is outside the SITE ENTRANCE GATES

On hearing the fire alarm

- The alarm is raised by a manually shouted warning of "FIRE FIRE FIRE"
- On hearing the alarm stop what you are doing and leave any building by the nearest available Fire Exit closing doors behind you
- Vacate the site and report to the designated Assembly Point which is outside the SITE ENTRANCE GATES

Fire Marshals and Supervisors

- Sweep the site (including back areas) to ensure all persons including staff, members of the public, contractors and other visitors are evacuated promptly and safely
- Ensure the Fire Service has been dialled on 999
- If safe to do so turn off mains electricity before leaving any building
- Shut off any drainage penstock valves to ensure fire water containment on site
- Meet at the Assembly Point and check all individuals are accounted for
- Liaise with Fire Service on their arrival and ensure their unhindered access to site
- Ensure nobody re-enters the site until confirmed safe to do so by the Fire Service

- DO NOT PANIC – DO NOT RUN
- DO NOT attempt to fight the fire unless you have been trained in the use of extinguishers and you are confident the fire can be dealt with safely
- DO NOT put yourself at risk e.g. DO NOT stop to collect personal belongings
- DO shut doors behind you
- DO report missing persons at the Assembly Point
