Hi Keith,

Further to our conversation I am writing to you to summarise our discussion.

The Trial conducted demonstrated no non-compliances of the ELVs for CO or NOx at emission point ST2. Such monitoring can be counted as compliance monitoring for this year. There is therefore no need to conduct further compliance testing of ST2 for CO & NOx this year. Obvious, monitoring for other determinands and at other emission points must still be completed as per permit requirements.

We have advised that the Permit must be varied to accommodate your proposed increase of the reference period and ELV averaging period for CO & NOx at ST2 to the equivalent of a shift. I am currently liaising with our Permitting department regarding the category of variation this is deemed to be. Currently it is thought it will be a Minor Technical, however, this is dependent upon the requirement for H1 assessments and modelling, which I will also review and report back to you on.

Please keep me updated on further ongoing investigations which we will support. We will not enforce the CO and NOx ELV for ST2 in non-standard conditions associated with such investigations provided we are kept informed of progress.

I will be in contact with you shortly regarding the variation.

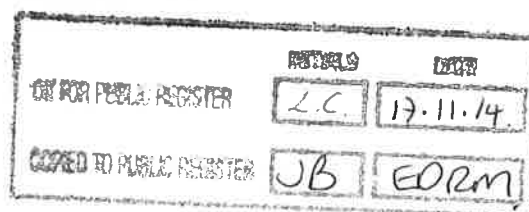
