Stuart,

Apologies for the delay in getting back to you.

Our proposal to minimise the impact of the raw mill rejects system is to provide a recirculation system for the material that is currently rejected to outside.

The proposal is to utilise/provide

The existing 16m<sup>3</sup> storage bin, with a low friction lining in the base cone area, and vibrators to be positioned on the lower cone to prevent blockages.

A silo measuring device is required so that the hopper material level can be monitored to prevent over filling the bin. A small conveyor belt low speed VSD. The belt is to have inverter control so the belt speed can be adjusted to the optimum speed to suit the new system.

A new over band magnetic belt and metal detector on/over the new belt.

Large access hatches on the existing hopper

A two-way material valve, air cannons and associated equipment.

The required equipment and tasks are:

- Removal of existing vibrating conveyor.
- Strip down & salvage of any reusable parts.
- Fabricate, supply and fit all new chutes, cleaning hoppers and pipe work.
- Installation of modified conveyor belt and associated equipment.
- Electrical works to integrate new system with the existing one.



A capital expenditure request has been submitted through the approval channels within Hanson to fund the required work. It is anticipated that should this be approved, the required works will be completed within the first quarter of 2015. This should eliminate the requirement to reject stone outside and thus eliminate the noise and dust from this area.
