Please provide:

An amended dust management plan that includes (but not limited to) information on the points below:

- Addition of a risk assessment of dust on the nearest receptors.
- Information of other nearby sources of dust in the area.
- Information on persons (on site and/or off site) responsible for amending the dust management plan.
- Details on the frequency of visual checks.
- Details on procedures when excess dust has been identified either through monitoring or visual and procedures to deal with such situations.
- Details on procedures and actions if the event that mitigation/control measures fail.
- Confirmation if the lorries transporting the dusty waste are covered/sealed and procedure for transportation of dusty waste.
- Confirmation if (or when) waste is rejected if it is determined to pose high risk of dust emission.
- A map showing the nearest sensitive receptors to the site and predominant wind direction.
- Section “1.8 Record keeping” is listed in the contents but is missing from the submitted version. Please can you supply how record and monitoring data is kept.
