### **Introductory note**

#### **This introductory note does not form a part of the notice**

The following notice gives notice of the variation of an environmental permit.

This variation is to allow an increase in the capacity of the bag filter units for production lines Niro 1 and Niro 2. This will allow the production capacity to be maintained during production of low melt point waxes.

The variation also allows for the installation of a powder mixing facility and a separate Nitrogen generation and storage facility, replacing the use of bottled Nitrogen. The mixing facility and Nitrogen production/storage have no new emission points associated with them. The Nitrogen production has been added to Table S1.1 as a listed activity.

The variation also includes an amendment to the site plan to extend the site boundary to include an area of land to the top left of the site which has not previously been included in the permit boundary.

Natural Resources Wales has also taken this opportunity to include an improvement condition requiring the operator to re-assess the sites operations against the low impact installation criteria. The operator must then submit a report on its findings to Natural Resources Wales, as detailed in the improvement condition.

The schedules specify the changes made to the original permit.
