**Environmental Permitting Regulations (England and Wales) 2010  
Temporary Water Treatment Plant**

I refer to the information submitted by e-mail on the 6<sup>th</sup> of March requesting the use of a temporary water treatment plant to treat water being pumped from excavation works and discharge to the White Sands Gutter. Natural Resources Wales agrees to this activity being carried out within the conditions of your Environmental Permit.

The discharge will need to be monitored frequently to ensure that it will not cause the permitted limits to be breached, and to ensure there is no carry over of flocculated solids. Please could you let me know what the monitoring regime will be.

If any problems are encountered with the quality of the treated water, the discharge must be stopped.

Agreement to this activity does not prevent Natural Resources Wales from taking enforcement action should pollution occur.
