Use of Pilot Effluent Treatment Plant at Tata, Shotton**

I refer to your previous discussions with my colleague Matthew Kelk and subsequent correspondence relating to the use of a pilot effluent treatment plant to assess the effectiveness of alternative treatment techniques.

The information you have submitted provides adequate assurance that the plant can be run alongside the existing plant and I am able to agree to its use for trial purposes for a maximum of six months from the date of this letter. If further trials are needed beyond this time you will need to agree an extension of this permission with your regulatory officer.

All emissions from the effluent plant will need to comply with the current emission limits and if treated effluent from the pilot plant does not meet these conditions it will need to be re-treated as described in your management procedures.

A summary of the performance of the pilot plant should be submitted with each quarter's emissions monitoring reports for the duration of the trial.
