Schedule

The following information is required in order to assess the permit application for the Shotton Works installation:

1. In relation to the proposed regenerative thermal oxidiser at the Coatings 2 plant, please assess the impact of sound on nearby sensitive human receptors and designated habitats sites, and demonstrate that you are using Best Available Techniques to minimise any noise impact.

The assessment for human receptors must use the methodology given in BS4142:2014 "Methods for rating and assessing industrial and commercial sound" and if modelling files are required as part of the impact assessment you must provide the information required in the following document -

For ecological receptors, you may want to consider the World Health Organisations guideline values for community noise in the preservation of quiet outdoor areas. The assessment must include an evaluation of the character of the sound e.g. frequency components.

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
