Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council would like to apply to transfer the permit BJ5775IF from Neath Port Talbot (Recycling) Ltd.

NRW has advised that this should be by formal transfer, and as such I would be glad if you could accept this letter as our formal request to transfer permit BJ5775IF.

Background

Neath Port Talbot (Recycling) Ltd is the current operator of the Materials Recovery and Energy Centre at Crymlyn Burrows and provides waste services to the Council and Bridgend County Borough Council (the Council's partner authority).

Neath Port Talbot (Recycling) Ltd is a wholly owned subsidiary of the Council's arm's length company, Neath Port Talbot Waste Management Company Ltd. The Council has taken the decision to bring the arm's length operation in-house, and to wind-up both Neath Port Talbot (Recycling) Ltd. and Neath Port Talbot Waste Management Company Ltd.

The Council will take the NPTRL operation in-house "as-is". We will maintain both the current management structure and the current management systems. The current WAMITAB officer will remain in post and all agreed operating techniques would continue.

The management team will report to the Head of Streetcare who will report to the Director of Environment.

In pre-application discussions, the Council and NRW acknowledge that whilst the current Permit does not accurately reflect the operations on site, the permit will be regularised after the permit transfer. Such regularisation will account for the removal of the waste to energy operation as has been discussed. Any further operational changes will also be included as appropriate, following the outcome of staff consultations after transfer.


