Nia,

As discussed yesterday, I'm happy for the ducting modifications to go ahead on Emission Point 93, which will split the hot air from the oven emissions into a separate point. Our guidance suggests that adding an emission point to a permitted facility that requires no formal assessment should be a minor technical variation. I'm comfortable with this change being incorporated into the permit formally during the next permit review or if a future variation is applied for, as detailed under condition 1.5.1. Can you send me a copy of the finalised installation drawings and photos once complete for the file?

Finally, the addition of extraction fans to remove clean air from the production building doesn't not require any amendments to the permit. However, in lieu of recent events I would recommend that any additional noise contribution from extraction fans is considered as part of the installation.

Hi Aled,

Further to my telephone conversation back in July.

Please could we have permission to split emission point 93 (4<sup>th</sup> process jet zone bleed) into two emission points. The majority of the hot air within the Jet zone oven zones is recirculated but a small proportion has to be bled off. The oven has two zones and the intention is to separate the bleed air from these zones so that zone 1 air is vented through the roof to atmosphere. This new duct will only vent hot air only and there will be no increase in noise as the existing zone 1 fan motor will remain in its current location.
