Hi Nia,

As discussed, some general comments with regards to the noise report conducted by S. Belkiri on behalf of Kellogg's:

- The report in its present format is difficult to read and appears to omit some supporting information, is a full copy of the report and supporting information available, preferably electronically?
- The map quality does not allow for us to see the exact external monitoring locations.
- Without the supporting information we cannot make any assessment with regards to the BS4142 conclusions in the report.
- Perimeter readings are stated as 1min averages, yet there is no mention of monitoring lengths at the receptors in Is-y-Coed.
- There are no L_{90} results in the whole report
- The 1/3 Octave work carried out only covers frequencies between 30-110Hz and not the whole spectrum.
- Some of the 1/3 Octave results are noted as above the reference curve; is the consultant suggesting that due to BS8233 these are therefore screened out? There is no commentary or explanation given for these inferences.
- Some of the results obtained at the installation boundary (locations 43-48) are considered "generally loud" (≥ 50 dB(a)) for night time, although we cannot draw any conclusions with regards to potential effects at receptors due to the issues above.

These are some of our main concerns with the report, which we can discuss in more detail next week.
