Hi Steve,

Further to your request, I agree that you can collect samples from the scrubber stack as proposed (i.e. not from stack sample ports as per normal requirements).

Whilst it may be useful process data, we do not actually require you to monitor odour units into the scrubber nor hydrogen sulphide or ammonia at any point.

Scrubber flow and efflux velocity will be required for the modelling to provide a predicted ground level concentration.

If we believe that the permit has been breached due to odour from the scrubber then MCERTs testing may be required. However based upon the absence of odour complaints to date this appears unlikely. Please also keep a record of your sniff tests and provide this to supplement your final report.

Hi Stuart

I have obtained costs for both Mcert and an alternative from Matt Houseman. The cost of Mcert is significantly higher at £6690 opposed to £2694. The odour abatement is running well and we are also completing checks for odour, although this is only a basic sniff test in the area we are also not receiving odour complaints. If at a later date we start receiving complaints then I would not be able to argue that we need to do Mcert to verify the performance of the system.

I have attached the method proposed by Matt Houseman. Hope you find this acceptable.
