I am the POA Plant Manager whilst Dhillip Sankoomar is on holiday.

Further to the below, please find attached a Part A notification to pre-notify NRW that BHP Billiton plans to take the Point of Ayr Tail Gas Unit offline on 22nd August, as discussed with you on 25th July. Our shutdown is scheduled to commence on 29th August, one week after this date.

Our planned shutdown duration has now been shortened, therefore the period for which we plan to run without the TGU online after shutdown has extended from 1 week to 2. We will of course work to minimise this.

During these two periods of operating the plant without the TGU online, we will continue to monitor SO2 and NOX emissions, and also to conduct daily odour checks at the site perimeter.
