**Environmental Permitting Regulations (England and Wales) 2010
Shotton Works Landfill, Environmental Permit Number:- GP3030BE**

I refer to your letter dated the 5th November 2014 requesting the addition of Saturated or Spent Ion Exchange Resins (EWC Code 190905) to schedule 3 of environmental permit GP3030BE.

Due to the characteristics of the waste and being classified as non hazardous, Natural Resources Wales accept the proposed change to schedule 3 and are satisfied that this can be agreed at a local level without varying the permit.

These wastes must be handled in a way that minimise all risks to the environment, this will be audited at future inspections.
