

Natural Resources Wales permitting decisions

Full transfer

We have decided to grant the transfer for Ruabon Electroceramics from Morgan Technical Ceramics Ltd to CeramTec UK Ltd.

The permit number is EPR/PP3834CB.

We consider in reaching that decision we have taken into account all relevant considerations and legal requirements and that the permit will ensure that the appropriate level of environmental protection is provided.

Key issues of the decision

Permit Transfers of this type involve a fixed, reduced application fee as long as it can be confirmed that the management of the installation is substantially the same under the new Operator as the incumbent. This was confirmed to be the case.

CeramTec UK Ltd have confirmed that they hold an ISO 14001 approved Environmental Management System at the Ruabon Site, assessed by Lucideon on the 3rd April 2017.

The Operational Risk Assessment for the site has been checked and no changes have occurred.
