Any more accurate information on the matters for notification under Part A.	The North West surface water lagoon has a low level of water at the time of sampling. Return of Canada Geese in the lagoons could be adding to the nutrient content of the water which in turn could be affecting the water chemistry. During April we had record numbers of Great Crested Newts identified in the North West Lagoons which provides a good indicator of general water quality within the ponds.
Measures taken, or intended to be taken, to prevent a recurrence of the incident	We will continue to monitor surface water quality, to assess if this minor breach in limits may be caused by increased wildfowl numbers on the ponds.
