

Natural Resources Wales permitting decisions

Cwmrhydyceirw Quarry Landfill, permit variation Decision Document

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NRW Led Variation

The variation number is: EPR-TP3835LV/V004

The operator is: SI Green UK Limited

The Installation is located at: Cwmrhydyceirw Quarry Landfill, Vicarage Road, Cwmrhydyceirw, Morriston, Swansea, SA6 6DR.

We have decided to issue an Natural Resources Wales initiated variation for Cwmrhydyceirw Quarry Landfill Site operated by SI Green UK Limited.

We consider in reaching that decision we have taken into account all relevant considerations and legal requirements and that the permit will ensure that the appropriate level of environmental protection is provided.

Purpose of this document

This decision document:

- explains how the application has been determined
- provides a record of the decision-making process
- shows how all relevant factors have been taken into account

Unless the decision document specifies otherwise we have accepted the applicant's proposals.

Key issues of the decision

Why the variation is needed

This is an Natural Resources Wales (NRW) led variation of the Cwmrhydyceirw Quarry Landfill Site permit – TP3835LV. Permitting received the variation request from the Industry Regulation South West Team.

It is known that the financial provision for the site will need to be updated and the relevant permit condition has been updated to allow a new agreement to be reached. The site has been capped, however still requires the deposit of restoration materials to allow appropriate planting and restoration.

The changes

The variation:

Updates permit condition 1.3.1 to allow future changes to the financial agreement to be agreed and put into place;

Varies Table S1.1 and adds Table S2.2 to allow the deposit of waste for recovery; and;

Adds pre-operational condition J1 to table S1.4 to ensure that the deposit of waste for recovery is appropriately controlled.

The site

There will be no change in the permit installation boundary as a result of this variation.

ANNEX 1: Pre-operational Conditions

J1	The operator shall submit to Natural Resources Wales a waste recovery plan, and shall have approval in writing from Natural Resources Wales before undertaking this activity. The waste recovery plan shall be prepared in accordance with the guidance available on gov.uk website (https://www.gov.uk/guidance/waste-recovery-plans-and-permits). The waste recovery plan shall also include waste acceptance procedures and, if waste is to be stored prior to use, give details of maximum storage times.
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
