Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016 Regulation 61(1)

Notes:

General

1. For the purposes of discharging its functions under the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016, Natural Resources Wales may (by virtue of Regulation 61(1) of those Regulations), require any person to provide information.
2. Failure to comply with this notice without reasonable excuse is an offence under Regulation 38(4)(a) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016, and may lead to legal action being taken against you.
3. Making any statement in response to this notice that you know to be false or misleading in a material particular, or recklessly making any statement which is false or misleading in a material particular is an offence under Regulation 38(4)(b) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016, and may lead to legal action being taken against you.
4. There is no right to appeal against this notice.
5. You may wish to seek independent legal advice.

Legislation note

In this document “Natural Resources Wales” means the Natural Resources Body for Wales established by Article 3 of the Natural Resources Body for Wales (Establishment) Order 2012. On 01 April 2013 the Natural Resources Body for Wales (Functions) Order 2013 transferred the relevant functions of the Countryside Council for Wales, and functions of the Environment Agency and the Forestry Commission in Wales to the Natural Resources Body for Wales.

This information notice requires you to provide the information specified below and relates to the following conditions of Permit Number WP3636ZG: 1.1.1 The operator shall manage and operate the activities: (a) in accordance with a written management system that identifies and minimises risks of pollution, including those arising from operations, maintenance, accidents, incidents, non-conformances, closure and those drawn to the attention of the operator as a result of complaints; and (b) using sufficient competent persons and resources. 1.1.2 Records demonstrating compliance with condition 1.1.1 shall be maintained. You are required to produce to NRW the following records, which you are required to keep by condition 1.1.2, with respect to condition 1.1.1 (b), for the period July and August 2022 for the HDU in Wrexham, Permit Number WP3636ZG. This shall include, but not be limited to: (1) The names of relevant personnel on each shift (i.e. Team Leader, Assistant Team Leader and Operators) and their training records relevant to ensuring permit compliance	Electronic or hard copy	midday 12 September 2022
