Please provide a brief description of the proposed project, including location.

Project location is at 599 Newport Road, Cardiff, on the banks of the River Rhymney.

The proposed works to be undertaken at Newport Road are to provide a long-term stability and strength solution to the existing sheet piles located along the River Rhymney bank. It was found during construction works for new apartments that the existing sheet piles were moving and upon further investigation it was found that the original tie rods / rock anchors supporting the sheets piles were either severely corroded or snapped and therefore were failing.

New, Double Corrosion Protected Bolts (DCP) will be drilled into the ground and fixed into existing bedrock to approx. 25m on the landside of the sheet piles and then fixed at the outside face of the sheet piles via a waling beam positioned on the outer face of the sheet piles prior to grouting, tensioning and testing.

The preferred option is to use a suitable Piling method which can be achieved from the landward side of the sheet piles thus minimising loading onto the existing sheet piles.

This method statement includes the following items:

- Installation of temporary works to allow access to waling beam
- Installation of temporary works to allow for suitable access for piling rig;
- Pile installation and grouting activities;
- Maintenance of temporary works;
- Removal of all temporary works.
