In terms of the Band 1 application for the benthic survey. Our standard response to these is as follows:  
“We have no objections to the proposed survey on the basis of any impact that it might have on underwater cultural heritage. The only caveat to this would be that there are a large number of documented losses of ships in Welsh waters for which there is no confirmed location. There is therefore some potential for encountering previously unknown seabed remains. In the unlikely event of that happening, we would be very grateful if you could inform us of the location and the nature of anything found.”

And I can confirm that this would apply to the Llŷr Band 1 survey.
