Just catching up with this. Essentially we have no objections to the work on the basis of any impact to marine archaeology or marine historic assets. This kind of work is always interesting from an archaeological perspective because of its potential to inform of any preserved former land surfaces beneath the modern ones – peat layers being the main indicator of these. With this in mind, we would be grateful if any subsequent reports into the ground investigation could be circulated to ourselves. Hello Julian,

Thank you for your swift reply.

To answer your queries:

- 1) Am I right in understanding that the 5 windowless samples, to 6m will be going into what is effectively the top of the existing seawall through the walkway?
Yes, correct into the top of existing sea wall.
- 2) What sort of depth do you envisage the 22 cores extending to? Both the horizontal ones, and the 45 degree ones?
I will need to check this with the Designers.
- 3) What sort of analysis will be undertaken on the cores?
 - Natural moisture content;
 - Atterberg limit tests;
 - BRE Digest SD1 : 2005 Concrete Aggressivity Suite – (Suite B)
 - Quick Undrained Triaxial Compression
 - Uniaxial Compressive Strength (UCS) of rock

The application is being submitted as a Band 1 Marine Licence.

I have also attached the initial specification from the Designers, which will hopefully provide some additional information to assist your review.

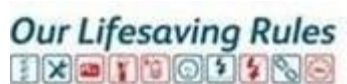
