Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the proposed sediment grab sampling for ground investigation works at 6 sites in Wales. The UK Technical Services Navigation team of the Maritime and Coastguard Agency has reviewed the information provided and would like to comment as follows:

On the understanding that the following takes place, the MCA would have no significant concerns to raise with regards to the safety of navigation and would be satisfied that the risk is relatively low on this occasion:

1. All maritime safety legislation is adhered to;
2. Local mariners and fishermen's organisations must be made fully aware of the activity through a local notification. This must be issued at least 5 days before the commencement of the works.
3. Zone29@hmcg.gov.uk and Zone30@hmcg.gov.uk must be notified prior to commencement of activities.

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Good afternoon MCGA,

I am contacting you today in relation to Marine Licence applications with Natural Resources Wales.

We have been given six remits to undertake ground investigation works along sections of the coast where the railway infrastructure requires protection. The G.I data will then inform permanent designs for coastal protection works.

The sites in question include:

- Old Colwyn
- Tywyn

- Afon Wen
- Llanaber
- Pwll
- Sudbrook

I have attached site plans for each location that also includes a works description, but in brief the works involve:

1. Hand excavation of inspection pits up to 1.2m in depth, to provide full visual inspection. On completion the hole will be backfilled in layers and hand tamped as the backfilling progresses to prevent any future settlement.
2. Dynamic sampling using a modular rig; sampling through superficial soils and (where necessary) basic rotary drilling (usually of hardstanding). Modular Rig Method Statement attached for additional details.

All these works will be carried out from the beaches and existing sea walls. Access will be from the landward side and there is no requirement to use any vessels.

Please can I ask that you review our work scopes and confirm whether you have any concerns relating to these works and if there are any control measures we need to include when undertaking these operations.
