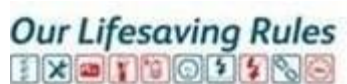

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the proposed minor maintenance at 5 locations in Gwynedd, North Wales. The UK Technical Services Navigation team of the Maritime and Coastguard Agency has reviewed the information provided and would like to comment as follows:

We Note that the work will comprise of re-pointing, filling voids in stonework, minor concrete repairs, reinstating a fence line and installing tab markers to structures.

On the understanding that the following takes place, the MCA would have no significant concerns to raise with regards to the safety of navigation and would be satisfied that the risk is relatively low on this occasion:

1. All maritime safety legislation is adhered to;
2. Local mariners and fishermen's organisations must be made fully aware of the activity through a local notification. This must be issued at least 5 days before the commencement of the works.
3. Zone29@hmcg.gov.uk and Zone30@hmcg.gov.uk must be notified prior to commencement of activities.

Can you confirm that you accept the risk mitigation above.
