Emission monitoring agreement

Permit reference: EPR/DP3137EG

In accordance with permit condition 3.6.1 and Schedule 3(b) Table S3.1 we confirm the following change to the monitoring requirements, which will remain in force until such time as we confirm otherwise in writing:

For monitoring specified in Schedule 3(b) – Emissions and monitoring effective from 3 December 2023, Table S3.1:

- Mercury and its compounds – bi-annual periodic monitoring is not required

As per footnote 1 in Schedule 3(b) Table S3.1 continuous monitoring of mercury and its compounds does not apply for plants incinerating wastes with a proven low and stable mercury content. We will review the monitoring requirement for continuous monitoring of mercury and its compounds following submission of such proof.

As per footnote 2 in Schedule 3(b) Table S3.1 monthly long term sampling monitoring of Dioxins/furans (I-TEQ) does not apply if the emission levels are proven to be sufficiently stable. We will review the monitoring requirement for long term sampling monitoring of Dioxins/furans (I-TEQ) following submission of such proof.
