**NOTICE TO REMOVE CONTROLLED WASTE AND REQUIREMENT TO TAKE
STEPS TO ELIMINATE/REDUCE CONSEQUENCES OF SUCH UNLAWFULLY
DEPOSITED WASTE**

Under Section 59(1)(a) and (b) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990, as amended, **Natural Resources Wales** can require removal of controlled waste or extractive waste and specify steps to reduce or eliminate the consequences of such deposits.

Being satisfied that the controlled waste namely approximately 30 end of life coaches and buses as pictured in photographs KB/1 Has been deposited at Mill Garages, Betws Gwerfil Goch, Corwen, LL21 9PU as shown edged red on the attached plan KB/2 In contravention of Section 33(1) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990, as amended and Regulation 12 of the Environmental Permitting (England & Wales) Regulations 2016, **Natural Resources Wales** requires you to remove the above mentioned waste by **1st March 2023**.

Natural Resources Wales also requires you to take the steps specified in Schedule 1 to eliminate or reduce the consequences of the deposit.

Section 59(1)(a) and (b)

Notes:

General

- 1 If you fail to comply with this notice Natural Resources Wales may take the steps and recover from you any expenses reasonably incurred in so doing.
- 2 Failure to comply with this notice is an offence under Section 59 (5) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990, as amended, and may result in legal action being taken against you.
- 3 You may wish to seek independent legal advice.

Appeal provisions

You are entitled to appeal against this notice under Section 59(2) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990, as amended. Notice of appeal must be made within a period of 21 days beginning with the service of this notice to a Magistrate's Court by way of a complaint. The requirements of this notice shall have no effect pending the determination of the appeal.

Legislation note

In this document "Natural Resources Wales" means the Natural Resources Body for Wales established by Article 3 of the Natural Resources Body for Wales (Establishment) Order 2012. On 01 April 2013 the Natural Resources Body for Wales (Functions) Order 2013 transferred the relevant functions of the Countryside Council for Wales, and functions of the Environment Agency and the Forestry Commission in Wales to the Natural Resources Body for Wales.
