Measures taken, or intended to be taken, to stop the emission	Following receipt of this result an investigation was completed. No causes for the exceedance were identified. It is believed that the limit of 0.25mg/L is too low to achieve. Following discussions with NRW, Dunbia have been in contact with a consultant and begun the process of completing a full H1 assessment review and variation application to request amendment to the W5 emission limit. We have arranged for the consultancy firm to attend site in Q1 to complete further data gathering. We hope to have this variation application submitted soon. We have opened up an investigation into the moss and algae that has started to build up in our surface water channels and plan to have this cleaned out and removed in 2023 as we believe there is a strong chance this is having an effect on the levels at W5.
