Good afternoon,

The LHA for Anglesey has requested Cadarn to undertake application of licenses to carry out regular maintenance of the outlets of highway drainage pipes located along the coast at Beaumaris and Llanfaes. I have listed the approximate locations and general details of the structures in the attached .xlsx files.

1. The client requires to undertake periodic clearance of material surrounding the outlets using a small machine and minimum personnel.
2. A Marine Management Organisation – Licence Requirement Check concludes that a MMO licence is not required.
3. Applied ecological Services Ltd have prepared an Extended Phase 1 Habitat Survey for the outlets at Beaumaris and at Llanfaes. It is concluded that the impact on the environment and associated ecology will be minimal and that a Band 1 application is undertaken to carry out eligible activity –“ clearance/removal of beach material in and around outfalls to aid drainage”.
4. Maine Licence application Guidance on the NRW webpage requires that I contact Maritime and Coastguard Agency and Trinity House to inform them of our intentions. It also stipulates that in the correspondence with MCA that I include details of the work (location, description, duration) and “**....Whether the works are within a Statutory Harbour Authority jurisdiction; applicants should check with the local harbour/marina if there is one. If yes, have they been contacted?**”

I would be most grateful if the relevant authority could respond with recognition of this correspondence so that I can proceed with the MCA engagement.

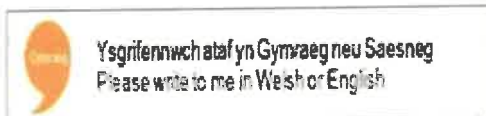
