MARINE AND COASTAL ACCESS ACT 2009: PART 4 – MARINE LICENSING

LICENCE TO DISPOSE OF DREDGED MATERIAL FROM CARDIFF BAY OUTER HARBOUR AND APPROACHES AT SEA

I am pleased to advise you that the Marine Licensing Team within Natural Resources Wales, on behalf of the Welsh Ministers, as Licensing Authority, has considered **Cardiff Harbour Authority's** email dated **10 January 2023** requesting an extension to a Marine Licence under Part 4 of the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009, and hereby grant the Marine Licence for you to undertake the above stated works.

Accordingly, please find attached for your review and retention a copy of Marine Licence **DML1930v5** and its conditions. Please note that Marine Licence **DML1930v5** supersedes Marine Licence **DML1930v4** in its entirety.

Licence has been varied to extend the licence end date from 01 March 2023 to 31 December 2023.

Advisory Note

Marine Licence, **DML1930v5**, constitutes a statutory consent; therefore the conditions set out herein must be complied with in full and will be binding upon any agent or contractor who undertakes any activity on the project on your behalf.

Marine Licence, **DML1930v5** is solely granted for the work to be undertaken with the area specified in the Licence; however, it does not absolve you from applying for further consents or licences as necessary to enable the full completion of your project.

If the works authorised by this Licence are unlikely to be completed by the expiry date, the Licence Holder should apply for a replacement marine licence **at least 4 months** prior to the expiry date of this Licence.

Should you require clarification as to the reasons for the inclusion of any of the conditions attached to the Licence then you must request written notice within 28 days of the receipt of this letter.

The licence has been varied to allow the ongoing maintenance at the Harbour and to allow the submission and determination of a new application for long term maintenance works at this location. We recognise that there has been delays in the analysis of your sampling which has impacted upon the submission of your application, however we would expect that the new application is submitted as soon as the analysis results are available, as we would not intend to extend the current licence further.

Finally, once again, please ensure you have read and understood Marine Licence **DML1930v5**. Should you have any queries with regards to your Marine Licence then please do not hesitate to contact the Marine Licensing Team.
