Good Morning Alun,

Thank you for the information below.

I cannot tell you exactly which one is quickest because I cannot foresee complications that might arise from consultation.

In theory – a band 1 application is for lower risk activities and they have a target determination of 6 weeks after a complete application has been received.

Opening a band 3 for variation results in at least a 28 day consultation process with no target determination. With a band 3 variation, your CEMP and WSI submission may also be affected too and put on hold until the variation of the licence is complete.

Once you have decided, can you please keep me informed of your decision.

Before I say which one of the two options is quicker can I just have some more information in terms of:

- Number of boreholes – 5No.
- Dimensions -100mm dia., between 1m and 5m deep
- Locations – are they outside of existing licence footprint? – They are within the footprint of the new structure, well within the licence footprint.
- Are these boreholes in the water or out of the water. – They are in the inter tidal zone, and will be undertaken on an outgoing tide.

This will determine whether the activity is quicker under band 1 or complex variation,

Good Morning Alun,

I am the case officer for your band 3 discharge of conditions so I can answer this query for you.

In terms of the window sampling survey below, in your current licence CML2128, boreholes are not listed as a licensable activity and I cannot see any information regarding borehole collection in the licence, so the current licence wouldn't allow you to carry out any sampling.

Our records do show you had a licence for collecting boreholes in 2019, however this licence has now expired.

If this is the case you options for carrying out the window sampling surveys are:

- Applying for a band 1 application for boreholes which has an SLA of 6 weeks and a cost of £600.
- Applying for a complex variation of your current licence which has no SLA deadline and has cost of £120 per hour.

No window sampling surveys can be carried out until you have it licenced under the options above.

There's an obligation on our contractor to undertake some window sample survey of the peat deposit up to 6m below beach level. The works are to be undertaken using a small 'Terrier' type tracked borehole rig, and will take 2-3 days to complete. The recovered samples are then to be analysed by a geoarchaeological specialist.
