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Dear Richard,

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the proposed band 1 Mumbles Coastal Protection Scheme of additional boreholes to the foreshore. The UK Technical Services Navigation team of the Maritime and Coastguard Agency has reviewed the information provided and would like to comment as follows:

On the understanding that the following takes place, the MCA would have no significant concerns to raise with regards to the safety of navigation and would be satisfied that the risk is relatively low on this occasion:

1. All maritime safety legislation is adhered to;
2. Local mariners and fishermen's organisations must be made fully aware of the activity through a local notification. This must be issued at least 5 days before the commencement of the works.
3. Zone28@hmcg.gov.uk must be notified prior to commencement of activities.

Can you confirm that you accept the risk mitigation above.

Good Morning,

I am writing in relation to the above proposed scheme. We have a band 3 Marine license in place (ref. CML2128) with NRW to cover the main body of works. However, unfortunately we need to undertake some additional ground investigation works in advance of the main contract which were not included in the original scope. As such we are in the process of applying for a band 1 license to cover some additional boreholes to the foreshore, in accordance with the attached. We will ideally be looking to undertake the works in the next few weeks and will be working between tides with no plant or materials left on the foreshore that could become a hazard to any wayfarers. Boreholes will be 100mm diameter less than 5m deep and we envisage they will naturally backfill on the incoming tide so there is no proposal to bring foreign material onto the foreshore.

Do you have any concerns with the proposals that we need to make NRW aware of, or can you confirm you have no issues with the proposed works?
