The annual report (2022 monitoring programme) identified 3 instances where the laboratory LOD (limit of detection) was increased to 0.002 mg/L (or 2 ug/L) at BH3/9 – this identified false exceedances at this location. Continued surveillance of MCPP concentrations in successive monitoring rounds, including UD and surface water monitoring locations.
