The annual report (2022 monitoring programme) identified a general increase in MCPP but this has been a result of the increased laboratory LOD (0.00008 mg/L). MCPP trend analysis has been undertaken for the site following a CAR Notice (received on 8th February 2023). The analysis identified MCPP exceedances occurred on occasion (between 2009 – 2022) at SW205 and SW206 but no obvious trend increases/decreases are identified. MCPP concentrations have remained relatively stable/consistent over the duration of the monitoring programme (between 2009 – 2022). Continued surveillance of MCPP concentrations in successive monitoring rounds, including UD and groundwater monitoring locations.
