Sorry for the late reply. Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the grab/sediment samples for scientific research. The UK Technical Services Navigation team of the Maritime and Coastguard Agency has reviewed the information provided and would like to comment as follows:

On the understanding that the following takes place, the MCA would have no significant concerns to raise with regards to the safety of navigation and would be satisfied that the risk is relatively low on this occasion:

1. All maritime safety legislation is adhered to;
2. Local mariners and fishermen's organisations must be made fully aware of the activity through a local notification. This must be issued at least 5 days before the commencement of the works.
3. Zone31@hmcg.gov.uk must be notified prior to commencement of activities.

Can you confirm that you accept the risk mitigation above.

Subject: Marine Band 1 application - Bangor University

Dear sir/Madam,

I am writing to check that the proposed activities for our Marine Band 1 licence application will not cause any undue navigational risk to sea traffic.

- The proposed work is to take grab/sediment samples for scientific research (Undergraduate and Postgraduate Teaching including Phd).
- Sites are yet to be determined but the application is in two parts ;
- Part 1 – Teaching (Day trips) between Sept and December onboard the RV Prince Madog, samples will be taken within the area (see attached map 1).
- Part II – Undergraduate and Postgraduate projects, will happen throughout the year within the waters surrounding Anglesey and North Wales (SEE attached MAP 2). This work will mainly be conducted on the smaller vessels Macoma /MYA using a hand operated grab with the occasional grab sample taken onboard the RV Prince Madog.
- The vessel will disengage power and display the relevant shapes/lights under the COLREGS when on station.
- Sampling time will be less than 10 minutes per station.
- Average sample size will be 0.002m³ (2ltrs) onboard the RV Prince Madog and 0.0005m³ (0.5ltrs) onboard the smaller vessels
- Samples will not be taken from Sensitive, protected or historical areas or within IMO TSS.
