RE: Access for Nant y Mwyn abstraction

Cambrian Environmental Technologies Ltd (CET) have been developing a Sustainable Active Treatment (SAT) System to remove and recover metals from circum-neutral mine water discharges. The development has been carried out with specific consideration for application to known abandoned mine sites within Wales that are causing pollution. A trial is being organised by CET on behalf of Natural Resources Wales (NRW) to test the CET system on the mine water from the Nant y Mwyn adit discharge.

Access for the abstraction of water from this discharge location for the trial is currently being organised by Tom Williams (NRW Lead Specialist Advisor Abandoned Mines). Dalcour Maclaren engaged through NRW's Land Agency Framework to secure access licences with landowners. It is expected that the access agreements will be formalised in June 2023.
