NOTIFICATION OF VARIATION OF CONSENT
for a discharge of treated sewage effluent

To : WELSH WATER AUTHORITY

This Notice is issued under the above-mentioned Acts and Order and all other enabling powers as a NOTICE DEEMED TO HAVE BEEN GIVEN BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR WALES, in respect of the existing discharge of treated sewage effluent from the Authority's :

LLANNOR SEWAGE TREATMENT WORKS

via an existing outlet and subject hitherto to a previous consent as specified below.

THE EXISTING OUTLET is to : the Afon Rhyd Hir

at National Grid Reference : SH 3504 3694

and has been shown marked : Discharge Point

on the attached Plan, No. : RW/0141/1/1

THE PREVIOUS CONSENT was : the Consent

Reference No. - 405

granted on : 27th July 1964

by : Gwynedd River Board

to : Lleyn Rural District Council

The Authority submitted this Notification of Variation on : 27th January 1981 to the Secretary of State for Wales in the form of a draft and the Secretary of State has NOT, within the relevant period, given notice of his intention to determine this matter. This discharge is therefore (in substitution for all the conditions hitherto in force) subject only to the following conditions as from : 27th April 1981

CONDITIONS

1. The discharge shall consist only of treated sewage effluent from the above works.
2. The quality and quantity of effluent shall not exceed the following maximum values:

<u>Determinand</u>	<u>Value</u>	<u>Unit</u>
Biochemical Oxygen Demand (+ATU) over 5 days at 20°C	55	milligrams per litre
Suspended Solids dried at 105°C	65	milligrams per litre

Rate of discharge	1.0	litres per second
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Volume during any period of 24 consecutive hours	90	cubic metres
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Volume discharged under 'dry weather conditions' during any period of 24 consecutive hours	30	cubic metres
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3. Adequate facilities shall be provided for the taking of samples of the effluent at: the outlet to the Afon Rhyd Hir

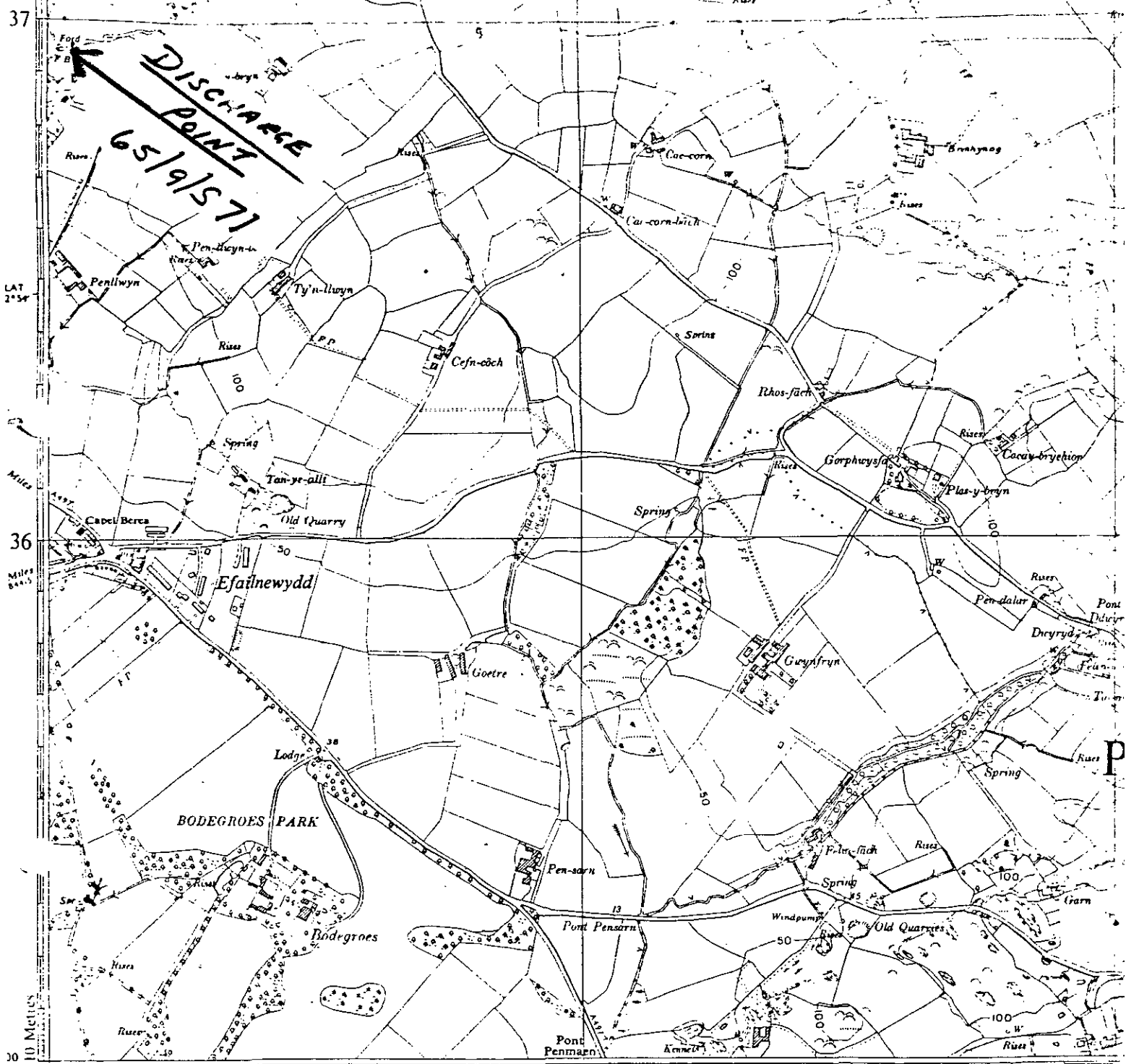

Rivers (Prevention of Pollution) Acts 1951 - 1961
Llanyer Sewerage and Sewage Disposal Scheme

With reference to your application of 7th May 1964, the Gwynedd River Board, in pursuance of their powers under the above Acts, hereby consent to the bringing into use of a new outlet for the discharge of treated sewage effluent and the making of a new discharge of treated sewage effluent into Afon Rhyd Hir at a point on the right bank in the South West corner of Enclosure No. 1273 of 1/2500th O.S. Map in accordance with the plan(s) attached hereto and numbered 84/194 and subject to the following conditions:

1. The volume of the discharge in any period of 24 hrs. shall not exceed 6,600 gallons (Dry Weather Flow).
2. The discharge shall at no time:-
 - (a) contain more than 30 parts per million of suspended matter dried at 105° C.
 - (b) take up more than 20 parts per million of dissolved oxygen in 5 days at 20° C.
 - (c) contain any matter to such an extent as to cause the stream water to be poisonous or injurious to fish, fish spawn or food of fish.

The terms of this consent will not, without the consent in writing of the person to whom this consent is given (or his successor), be altered before the expiration of the period ending with the 1st day of August 1966.

3. The bringing into use of a new outlet for this discharge at the outfall mentioned above subject to the effluent drain, where it discharges to the river, being suitably encased in a concrete or masonry headwall, such headwall to have its foundations set at least 2 feet below the bed of the stream.
4. Suitable sampling facilities being available so as to enable the Board's Sampling Officers to collect samples of the treated effluent discharged.
