Compliance Assessment Report

NRW officer David Ellar visited the site on 01/02/2023 and noted several significant non-compliances, these can be seen detailed CAR_NRW0041072. This CAR is now on our public register, but a copy is also attached to update email for your convenience. As a result of the permit breaches a Regulation 36 enforcement notice has been issued to ensure the site is brought back into compliance. NRW is considering the most appropriate enforcement response. NRW do have concern regarding the continued poor performance of the operator, and this is being taken into consideration. Actions identified in the CAR have already been undertaken by the site and these will be assessed during the next inspection.

Incident Feedback

Since the previous update, NRW has received only one incident report relating to the location, this incident was not related to waste activities on the site but alleged ground works to the south of the site. This issue was attended and looked at by NRW on the same day as the site visit (01/02/23). NRW have had no reports of noise or fires at the site.

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
